Focus: London In partnership with London Funders

London is a complex city with hundreds of grantmakers across sectors and thousands of recipients. One of the main challenges in understanding the grantmaking picture in London is understanding the geographical flows.

The total grantmaking of London Funders members is estimated to be £2.5 billion, with the largest being Charities Aid Foundation and the National Lottery Community Fund. However, not all the funds were awarded to organisations


based in London, and of those that were, a high proportion were to national and international charities.

Using the data published to the 360Giving Data Standard, we can see that of the grants to charity recipients registered in London, only a third of the amount awarded was to organisations operating in London only, with 57% going to national charities registered in London and 9% to charities with an international or overseas remit.

The majority of charity grant recipients operating in London only were small charities with income of under £1m.


London registered charities:






London Funders members: Who funds with who?
