

UKGrantmaking is the definitive annual publication on grant funding in the UK. It is a unique collaboration between 360Giving, the Association of Charitable Foundations, the Association of Charitable Organisations, UK Community Foundations and London Funders.

UKGrantmaking collates data from regulators, funder accounts and data published using the 360Giving Data Standard on grants made in 2022-23. It offers an interactive platform that showcases the data and insights on over £20bn of funding from across all grantmaking sectors to the voluntary, community and social sectors. It is an open and collaborative initiative and is intended to grow and evolve with each annual edition.

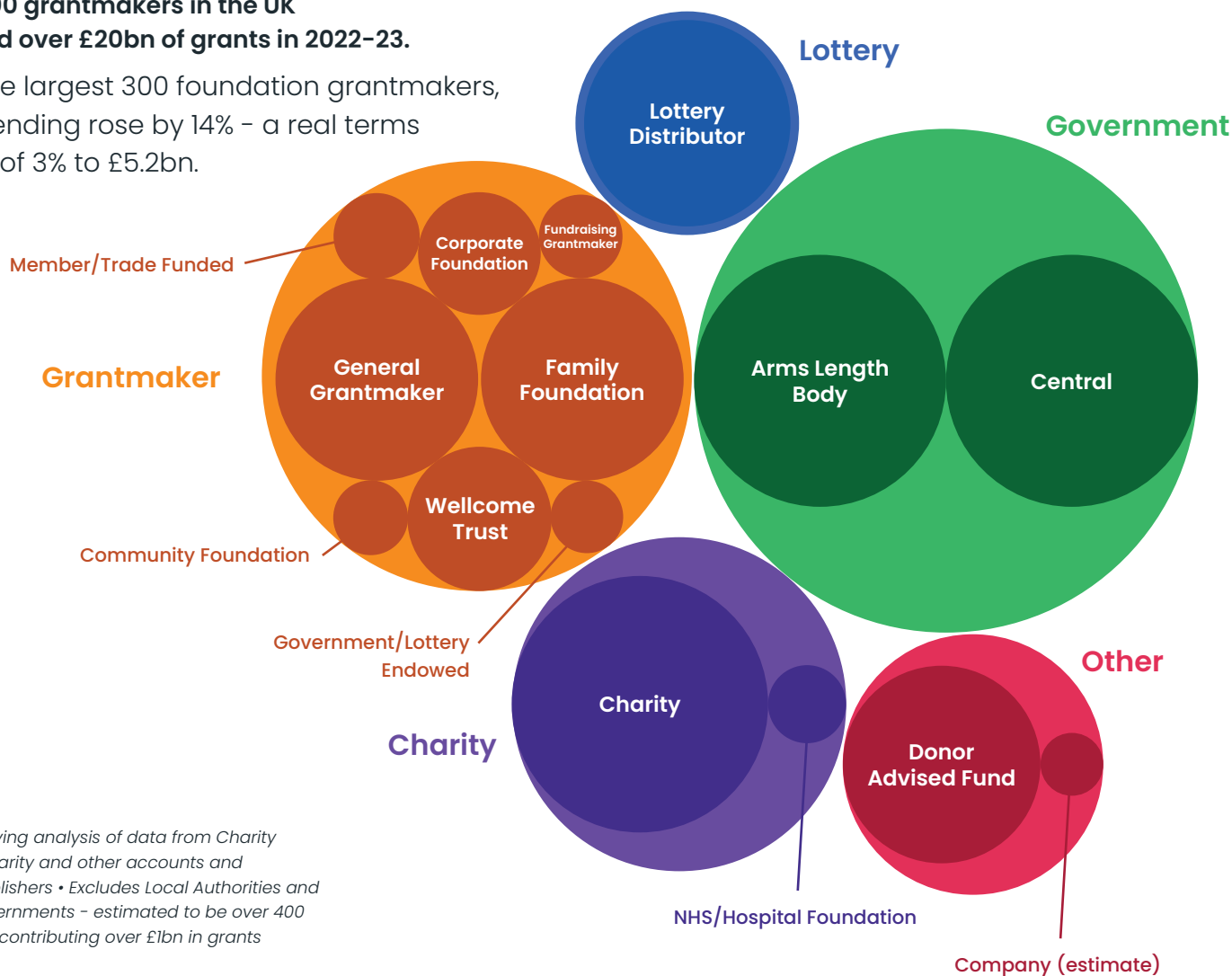
## Key findings

### Number and size of UK grantmakers

By grantmaking segment, 2022-23

Over 13,000 grantmakers in the UK distributed over £20bn of grants in 2022-23.

Across the largest 300 foundation grantmakers, grant spending rose by 14% - a real terms increase of 3% to £5.2bn.

The majority of grantmakers are small – only 8% distribute over £1m a year

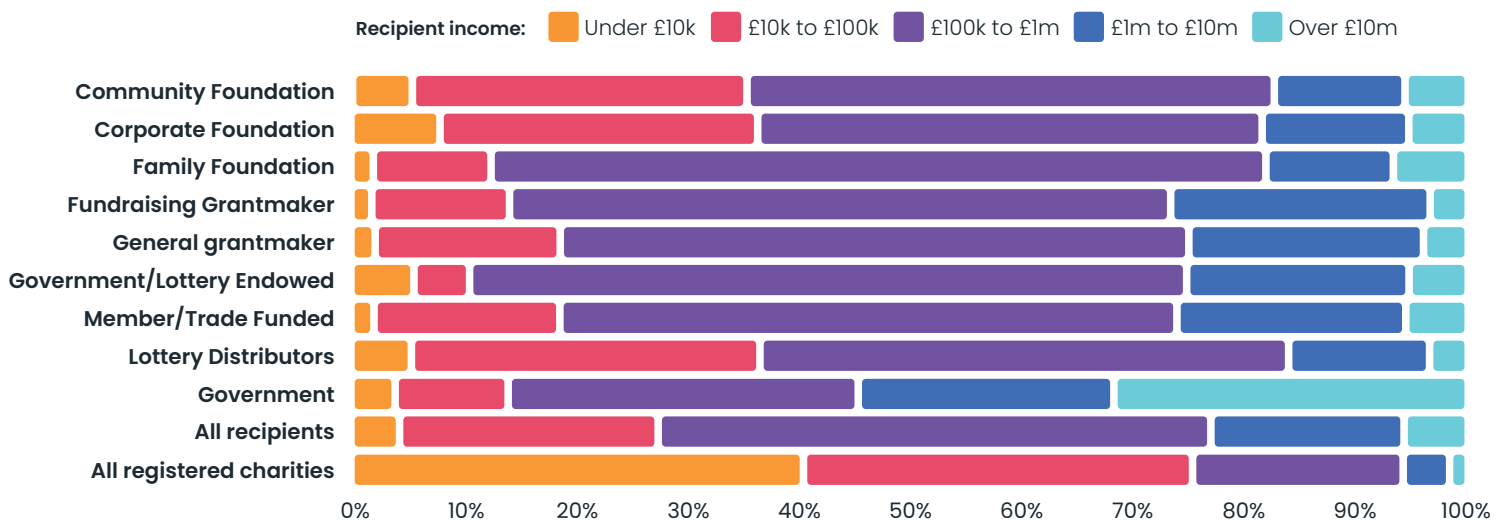

## Size of charity recipients

Proportion of grants, by income of recipient

The majority of recipients are also small – over 77% of those awarded grants in 2022–23 in data published using the 360Giving Data Standard reported income under £1m.

Recipients of grants most commonly supported children and young people and grants awarded were most commonly for a year or less and for under £10,000.
